How to Access the Food Connect Map

There are several ways to access TFP's Food Connect Map:

- From the TFP website www.foodpantries.org
 - Click on the green button – FIND FOOD NOW

How the data is organized

The Food Connect Map landing page is a interactive map, that is based on your devices location. You can use the menu on the left side of the screen to help narrow or broaden your search based on your needs.

The data is provided by categories and further delineated into sub-categories:

Each category and subcategories are noted by a different map marker.

By clicking on the map marker, the Map will provide a window that provides more details regarding the entity, a clickable weblink if provided, and the ability zoom specifically to the exact location of the entity.

Search Capabilities

The map has the ability to zoom in or out depending on the user's needs. It also has the capability search by specific name of an entity or a street address.
